Prayer Ministry

We are delighted to announce the launch of Prayer Ministry in our parish after all masses on the weekend of the **31st January/ 1st February** and monthly thereafter.

Prayer Ministry is an offering where two trained Prayer Ministers pray with and for a person to facilitate healing, bring comfort and guidance. Prayer ministry will take place in a corner of the church after mass. Music will be playing to ensure privacy. Two prayer ministers will ask what you would like prayer for. They will then pray with you for 3-5 minutes and invite the Holy Spirit to minister over you and your situation. Sometimes the minister will have a bible verse or a picture to share with you. It can be a moving and uplifting experience and most people leave feeling touched by the presence of God. We encourage you to give it a try!

Please note that in most situations what is said in prayer ministry remains confidential unless there is anything shared that indicates that the person who is being prayed for or someone else is at risk of harm. In this instance there will be a duty to follow diocesan safeguarding procedures and inform the relevant authorities.

Ladies Group We are a group of friendly lovely ladies who meet once a month for coffee and a chat. Our meetings are held on a Wednesday of the third week in the month, except August, in the Lounge of the Pastoral Centre 9.45am to 12.00. You can pop in at anytime within this time.
