At the Most Holy Redeemer our desire is to be able to support all of our families so that they are able to deepen their faith and come to an appreciation of the love that Jesus has for each one of us.

One of the main ways in which our children learn about their Catholic faith is through sacramental preparation but we are aware that the way we have traditionally undertaken this preparation hasn't always produced long lasting fruit. This is often because once the preparation has come to an end there is little that is currently offered to help families continue in their faith journey.

GIFT (Growing in Faith Together) is a new initiative which is intended to provide encouragement to families both before a child has celebrated the sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Communion and afterwards.

WHAT IS GIFT?

GIFT is for families with children who are baptised Catholics in school years 3-6, whether you are already engaged with your faith

and the Church or whether you are seeking the sacraments for your child but not as engaged as you would like to be.

The aim of GIFT is to provide a space for families to come together to learn what engaging with your faith actually looks like and then to walk alongside you in this process. You and your children will be attending the sessions together as well as having separate input aimed at parents and children.

During the sessions we will engage in activities and conversations that will help all of us to reflect on our faith and on how we can become Jesus' disciples.

HOW CAN I TAKE PART IN GIFT?

You can choose to join GIFT at any time in the year. All you need to do is to complete the registration form which is available in the church or from the Parish Office. The session dates for 2026/2027 are listed at the end of this leaflet.

Please note that you do need to have completed and returned the GIFT registration form to the Parish Office before you attend a GIFT session.

We ask for a £15 donation from each family to cover the cost of running the sessions. This can be paid in cash, through a bank transfer to the parish or by using the donation machine in the church porch.

WHEN WILL MY CHILD MAKE THEIR FIRST HOLY COMMUNION?

If your child has not made their First Holy Communion, then a conversation will take place between yourselves and the parish when you and we feel that your child is ready to receive the sacraments.

The key difference between GIFT and the traditional way of preparing children for the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion is that GIFT recognises that not every child will be ready to make their Holy Communion at the same time. Instead, reception of the sacraments will be based upon recognising your child's, and your family's understanding of what it is to be part of the Church family.

This means that celebrating the reception of the sacraments will take



place in the parish Masses at different times throughout the year rather than on a specific month over set weekends.

Once it has been discerned that your child is ready to receive the sacraments of Reconciliation and First Holy Communion you will be offered specific resources designed to help you prepare your children for the celebration of these sacraments.

WHAT IF MY CHILD HAS ALREADY MADE THEIR FIRST HOLY COMMUNION?

Children who are in school years 4-6 who have already made their First Holy Communion are encouraged to continue this GIFT pathway. They will have time together separately from the other children helping them to stay connected to each other and their faith.

WHAT IF I CAN'T MAKE ALL OF THE SATURDAY SESSIONS?

Our hope is that families will attend all of the GIFT sessions but we recognise that sometimes this isn't always possible. If you know that you are not going to be able to come to a session you will need to let us know in advance by emailing the Parish Office.

When discerning readiness for reception of the sacraments we will be looking at how engaged you are not only in the GIFT
