A message from Nathalie Watson on multiplication:

Over the past few years, my involvement in Alpha, the Life in the Spirit seminars, and our parish Connect Groups has shaped my faith in ways I didn't expect. Each step has deepened my relationship with God and has shown me how renewal can grow naturally within a parish when people simply walk together and share what they've received.

My journey began with Alpha. I appreciated the open, welcoming space it created, somewhere you could ask honest questions and explore faith without pressure. As the weeks went on, groups of people formed real connections. When Alpha finished, several people said they wanted to continue meeting and keep growing in their faith. Sensing this need, I offered to start and lead a Connect Group so that our journey together could continue.

Leading this Connect Group has been a real blessing. We meet regularly to pray, reflect on Scripture, and talk openly about our lives and faith. Over time, I've seen people grow in confidence, discover new aspects of their relationship with God, and support one another through challenges. What began as a small group has become a place of steady, genuine growth, and it has shown me what growth looks like in everyday parish life: faith deepening, people encouraging one another, and a community slowly expanding.

The Life in the Spirit seminars prepared me for this in an important way. They helped me become more aware of the Holy Spirit's guidance and His renewed outpouring, bringing clarity, courage, and a rekindled sense of purpose, giving me a clearer sense of the gifts I might offer in service. I began discerning the Charisms God may be calling me to use and felt an increasing pull to step forward and contribute more fully to the life of the Church. This experience eventually led me to train as a Parish Renewal Guide for our Diocese. In this new role, I now have the opportunity to begin to support other parishes as they explore their own paths of renewal.

Through Alpha, Life in the Spirit, my Connect Group, and Parish Renewal work, I've learned that multiplication isn't about big gestures or dramatic moments. It's about small steps of faith that encourage others to take their own. I'm grateful to be part of this ongoing journey and to see how God is quietly at work in our parish.
